### Course outline

#### Introducing NVivo and setting up a project

- Introducing NVivo's workspace
- What gets imported from bibliographic software

#### Working with your information

- Opening documents and PDFs
- Creating/using memos and annotations

#### Sorting, organizing and analyzing your information

- Identifying themes, topics and ideas and collecting data to support them
- Introducing 'nodes' including node folders and creating nodes

#### Exploring your data

- Using tools such as text search query, matrix coding query, and Framework Matrix
- Exporting your information

### What will you achieve from this course?

At the end of this eWorkshop, you will have the knowledge to set up a literature review in NVivo, and begin to work with your information. You will also be able to use NVivo to organize your content and begin to identify themes, topics or ideas.
